WINTER - September to April

- Pinafore Dress - Tartan
- Blouse - White with long sleeves
- Tie - Red elasticated
- Cardigan - Grey with red in cuffs
- Tights - Red PEX
- Coat - Dark grey GLOVERALL duffle coat
- Scarf - Red with grey stripes school scarf
- Gloves - Red or grey
- Clevelands Winter Hat - Red or grey
- Black Shoes - Laced or with Velcro (fashion shoes are not acceptable)
- Wellingtons (optional – any colour)

SUMMER - April to July

- Pinafore Dress - As for Winter
- Blouse - White short sleeves, with revere collar
- Cardigan - As for Winter
- Blazer - Red woollen school blazer
- Socks - Ankle socks, plain white
- Shoes - As for winter
- Hat (optional) - Straw boater with red trim
- Kagoule (optional) – Clevelands black kagoule

PE and GAMES

- Clevelands Aptus Badged Red Polo
- Clevelands Aptus Badged Black Skort
- Clevelands Aptus Badged Black 1/4 Zip Track Top

- Socks - Ankle socks, plain white
